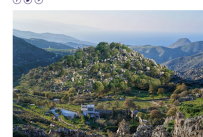

Xinara House, Tinos: A villa full of art and life on an island that is Greece at its unspoilt best

Sephia Constant had barely even heard of Tinos before she travelled across for a stay at Kikis's house; she came away wishing she could keep the company. *Amoskani* became my second life.

Things to do
